## ~ The Master Calls Men ~

As Jesus walked by the Sea of Galilee He saw two brothers, Simon and Andrew, who were casting a net into the sea, "for they were fishermen." Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men." The key word is become. They will enter a new state or condition. They will become something they had never been before. They will have a new purpose and mission. They will "become fishers of men." Are we fishers of men? Are we talking to anyone about Jesus? How can we persuade them to become a follower of Christ if we do not? Jesus called Simon and Andrew.

Jesus also called James and John. When He did they left their father in the boat with the hired servants and followed Jesus. In both cases there was a call. The call was actually a command. It was a call and command to follow Him. Men today are called to follow Jesus. How? Through the gospel (2 Thess. 2: 14). Through the gospel Jesus Christ has extended to you an invitation to follow Him.

Today's sermon, based on Mark 1: 16-20, will examine the call Jesus made to these fishermen. From that passage we will go to Matthew 11: 28-30 to see the call Jesus makes to us. That call does not come through some "still small voice" whispering in our ear. Nor does it come through a dream, vision or message written in the clouds. That call, I repeat, comes through the gospel (Rom. 1: 16). Please hear and answer Christ's call.
