## The Plan of Salvation

Last Sunday morning as we watched Christopher McElvain being baptized into Christ by his dad we were reminded of both the beauty and simplicity of God's plan of salvation. As I said in last Sunday morning's sermon, the plan for our redemption and salvation, as revealed in the Bible, should strike us with wondrous awe. When God created man (Gen. 1: 26-27) He created him with free will. Man has to choose to obey or not obey God's word (Josh. 24:15). It should strike us with awe that the plan for our salvation was in the mind of God "before the foundation of the world" (Eph. 1:4).

While God's plan for our salvation strikes us with awe, it also impresses us with its beauty and simplicity. God sets forth in His inspired word (2 Tim. 3: 16-17) the things required for one to become a Christian. We must first hear the gospel (Rom. 10:17), "the power of God to salvation" (Rom. 1:16). Then we must respond to that gospel in faith: faith in God (Heb. 11: 1, 6), His Son (Jn. 8:24), and His word. Next we must turn from our sins in repentance (Lk. 13:3, 5) and confess the name of Christ before men (Rom. 10:10).

Finally, we must be baptized by immersion in order to receive the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; see Acts 22: 16; 1 Pt. 3:21). By obedience to the gospel of Christ we are saved and added to His church (Acts 2:47). Have you obeyed the gospel?
