Last week we began a series of lessons on the final week in the life of Jesus prior to His crucifixion and resurrection. These events included the arrival of Jesus and His disciples at Bethany on Friday afternoon before the start of the Sabbath (6 pm Friday to 6 pm Saturday.)

The Sabbath rest was followed by the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on Sunday (Mk. 11:1-10; Zech. 9:9), which was followed in turn by His visit to the temple (Mk. 11:11).

On His way into Jerusalem on Monday He cursed the fig tree (Mk. 11:12-14). He later cleansed the temple (Mk. 11:15-19). This was His second cleaning of the temple (Jn. 2:13-17).

On their way to Jerusalem on Tuesday Jesus used the withered fig tree to teach lessons on faith and forgiveness. The remainder of the day He dealt with a series of controversies and taught a series of parables.

Wednesday was a fairly quiet day as compared to the earlier days of the week. It is likely that Jesus returned to the temple to continue to teach (Lk. 21:37-38).

Today we continue to look at the last days of Jesus before His death. Thursday was a day filled with activity as Jesus prepared for His death on the cross. The disciples secured a room and prepared for the Passover meal. That same evening Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper. The group sang a hymn and left the city to go to the Mount of Olives, where Jesus would pray in Gethsemane.

The arrest, trials and death of Jesus were imminent (Mt. 26:46).
