THE RESURRECTION

For the last several Sundays we have been studying the events that make up the last week in the earthly life of Jesus prior to His crucifixion and resurrection. These include the things that are "of first importance" (1 Cor. 15:3). Today's lesson will focus on the bodily resurrection of our Lord from the tomb. We will look at several of the post-resurrection appearances of Jesus.

It would be easy to fill this article and the sermon with quotations from reliable scholars who believe that Jesus rose from the dead. Such an approach to the theme would be profitable. But that is not the approach we will take. We will look as closely as possible at several of His post-resurrection appearances.

However, let me share some quotations with you. "The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the cornerstone of Christianity" (Michael Green). "The resurrection...is the most important doctrine of the New Testament" (G. E. Ladd). Ladd added, "The resurrection may be called the major premise of the early Christian faith." And, "The cornerstone of the entire New Testament is the resurrection." Finally, "The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is foundational to the Christian faith" (L. J. Kreitzer).

The crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus are inseparable. In His death He was sacrificed for our sins (1 Cor. 15:3). In His resurrection He gave us "a living hope" of our resurrection (1 Pt. 1:3; 1 Cor. 15:20). All of the gospel is important. But the heart of it is the death, burial and resurrection of Christ.

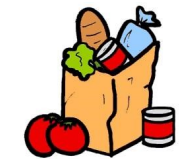
