* What Matters Most *

What matters most is your soul. On one occasion a young man came to Jesus. The incident is recorded in Matthew 19, Luke 18 and Mark 10. We often refer to him as the rich young ruler. The young man came running to Jesus, knelt before Him, and asked, "Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?" The Lord told the young man to keep the commandments of the Law of Moses. This prompted the young man to make the bold claim, "All these things I have kept from my youth." The young man then asked, "What do I still lack?" (Mt. 19:20).

Mark tells us that "Jesus, looking at him, loved him." Then the Lord added, "One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me." (See Matthew 16:24.) How did the young man react? "He was sad at this word." Or, "At this the young man's face fell" (NIV). Why? Because "he had great possessions."

The young man wanted eternal life, but he was not willing to pay the price to get it. He appears to have been eager, sincere, respectful and interested. But he was unwilling to part with his possessions. Those possessions stood between him and the Lord. Does anything stand between you and Jesus? Are you willing to give up whatever or whoever it is to follow Him? What/Who matters most to you?
