THE NEW SELF

When Paul wrote to the church in Ephesus, he described the way God wants His church to behave. He described this behavior in terms of becoming a “new self” (Ephesians 4:17-24). Basically, Paul taught that Christians should not live like the rest of the world. They should not even live as they naturally want to live. They should see themselves as completely new people. How should these new selves behave? Paul wrote: “**And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving on another, even as God in Christ forgave you**” (Ephesians 4:32). This is how God wants us to live.

Eight Mile Rock, Grand Bahama Island

Tavaro is married to the love of his life, Shameika, for 18 years now. They work beautifully together preaching and evangelizing as a team for the Lord's work west of Freeport Bahama in the Hanna Hill settlement of Eight Mile Rock. The new location of the church building just this year was also made possible because of Tavaro's sister and her husband Chad and Rhonda Neely. Their work and support helped secure a suitable place for the congregation to meet. The baptistry is now just steps away from the front door, which leads out to the Atlantic Ocean.

Tavaro is known for having Bible studies every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings at 5:30AM via ZOOM. Tavaro has a heart for evangelism and is always looking for ways to increase the knowledge of God's word throughout his congregation and community.

Our exploratory visit for future VBS and gospel meeting opportunities this past July gave us great insight for evangelism plans in 2024. They were celebrating their 50th Independence Day Celebration on July 10th, during our visit. While the weather was extremely hot, the hearts of the kids and members were a very welcome warmth to the soul. The VBS was followed with a gospel meeting during the evening.
