# THE ASCENSION

Today we conclude our series on the final week in the earthly life of Jesus. We understand that the ascension was not a part of that week, but took place forty days later (Acts 1:3). However, the ascension is a part of that series of events. We will study the ascension both this morning and this evening. The morning sermon will answer two questions: (1) What does the Bible say about what WOULD happen? (2) What does the Bible say about what DID happen?

Tonight's sermon will ask three questions: (1) Why did the ascension happen? (2) Where is the ascension referred to in the Bible? (3) What was the purpose of the ascension? These are all very important questions. We must know all we can about the life of our Lord and what it means to us.

God's people must never be satisfied with a superficial knowledge of His word. We can never know too much about the Bible. The psalmist wrote of the person whose "delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night" (Psalms 1:2). Paul wrote, "Meditate on these things" (Philippians 4:8; 1 Timothy 4:15).

We must study God's word to know God's word. We must know God's word to live by God's word. We must know God's word to teach it to others. "Be diligent/study to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing/handling aright the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15).
