Our Advocate

"We have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous" (John 2:1). An advocate is a person who pleads for or in behalf of another person. He is one who helps, counsels and supports us in our time of need. He is one who is called to stand beside another and plead his case. (Revelation 20:12)

Jesus is our Advocate because 1) His name Jesus means Savior or Deliverer. 2) Because of His title (Christ, Messiah, Anointed One). 3) Because He is "the righteous one", the only one qualified to intercede for us (Romans 8:34; Hebrews 4:15; John 1:29, 35; Exodus 12:5). Because He is "the propitiation for our sins" (1 John 2:2; 4:10; Romans 3:25).

The false teachers at Ephesus denied the deity of Jesus. They denied that He was the Messiah, the Son of God, and the Savior of the world. They denied His incarnation. They were among the antichrists because they rejected Jesus. (See 1 John 2:18, 2; 4:3; 2 John 7). Anyone who denies the deity of Jesus is an antichrist (1 John 2:22). Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God and the Savior of the world. (1 John 2:2; John 14:6; John 3:16-17).
