## + Prophecy and Promise +

Three times in the Gospel of Mark Jesus tells His disciples about what is going to happen to Him (8:31; 9:31; 10:32-34). We have already studied the first two passages; today we will study the third one. As Jesus and His disciples "were on the road going up to Jerusalem" (10:32), where Jesus would die on the cross for our sins, He warned the disciples of what lay ahead (10:33-34).

First, however, notice that Jesus referred to Himself as "the Son of Man." This term appears about ninety times in the Bible. It is used predominantly by Jesus in reference to Himself. It refers back to Daniel 7:13-14, where "One like a Son of Man was coming." This Person "came up to the Ancient of Days and was presented before Him." The Ancient of Days is God. The Son of Man was given dominion, glory and a kingdom that will never be destroyed. (See Daniel 2:44.) This "Son of Man" is a prophetic reference to Jesus.

What would happen to the Son of Man? He would be delivered to the chief priests and scribes, who would condemn Him to death and hand him over to the Gentiles, who would in turn mock Him, spit on Him, scourge Him and kill Him.

However, "three days later He will rise again." God raised His Son from the dead (Rom. 1:4). This is both a prophecy and a promise. In this brief passage the heart of the gospel is summarized. (See 1 Corinthians 15: 1-4).
