Thursday is Thanksgiving Day. Today we interrupt our sermon series on "The Case for Christ" to deal with the theme of thanksgiving. We will resume our series on Christ November 30 as we discuss "The Suffering Christ."

The Bible has much to say about thanksgiving. For example, "Offer unto God thanksgiving" (Ps. 50: 14). "O give thanks unto the Lord" (Ps. 105: 1). "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving" (Ps. 100:4). "Praise ye the Lord. O give thanks unto the Lord" (Ps. 106: 1). "O give thanks unto the Lord (Ps. 107: 1, 118: 1). We are to give thanks (Eph. 5: 4). "In everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God" (Phil. 4: 6). We are to give thanks unto the Father (Col. 1: 12). We are to abound with thanksgiving (Col. 2: 7). We are to be thankful (Col. 3: 15), and "continue in thanksgiving" (Col. 4: 2). In everything we are to give thanks (1 Thess. 5: 18, 1 Tim. 2: 1, 4: 3-4).

For what are we to give thanks? For our health, prosperity and country. We are to give thanks for family, friends and those who have gone before us. We are to give thanks for our food, clothing and shelter. We certainly are to give thanks for our spiritual blessings (Eph. 1: 3, Js. 1:17). We are thankful for our heavenly Father, our Savior, His Holy Spirit, the church, His word, and our forgiveness, hope and fellowship in Christ. Give thanks to the Lord!
