We will be focusing on puppets, art and debate in this practice. **After Wednesday Feb 9, 2021 – we will not make any changes to our lads registration. EVERY INDIVIDUAL ATTENDING CONVENTION MUST BE REGISTERED. If you are not registered you will NOT have a badge and be allowed to enter any events.** Additionally, we will not be able to make hotel changes after this point. 1. Masks must be worn by all individual at all times – NO EXCEPTIONS. This is a Lads to Leaders rule and will not change prior to convention. They are asking that presenters also keep their mask on. Clear face shields are an alternative. **We are planning to order clear face shields for our presenters so that they do not have to wear a mask while they are presenting or at least can have the choice. We will have these at practice as soon as we can get them in so that they can practice with them as well.**

2. No in person puppet presentations

We will have to do a daily COVID screening with questionnaire and temperature checks and you will receive a color coded badge so that you can enter convention areas and events.
