HOLINESS

Holiness is the quality or characteristic of being holy. To be holy is to be separate or set apart from sin, error, condemnation and death by God through Jesus Christ and His blood by obedience to the gospel.

Last Sunday we saw that God is altogether holy (Lev. 11: 44-45). Today we study the fact that we, His children, are to be God's holy people. First we will review what some OT passages say about God's holiness. Then we will see what the NT says about the fact that we are to be holy because God is holy.

We will examine one passage from the gospel accounts, then look at several from Paul and two from Peter. Those from Paul include 2 Corinthians 6: 17 - 7:1, Romans 6:19 and Romans 12:1-2. Those from Peter are 1 Peter 1: 15 and 1 Peter 2: 9-10. Those passages will be enough to persuade us that God's people must be holy people.

Why is it important that we study the need for holiness? (1) Because we live in a world inundated with evil. We are not to love the sinful world (1 Jn. 2: 15-17). To be a friend of the world is to be an enemy of God (Js. 4: 4). (2) Only holy people can penetrate the dark world of sin with the good news of Christ (Mt. 5: 13-16; Mt. 13: 33). (3) Holiness reflects the Father and the Son, the only hope this world has (Jn. 8: 24). God's people must be holy people!
