Pilate turned Jesus over to the soldiers who beat, spit on, and slapped Him. They put a crown of thorns on His head, a reed scepter in His hand, a dirty robe on His back, bowed before Him in mock homage, and led Him away to crucify Him.

The soldiers, followed by a mob, led Jesus to Golgotha. A man, Simon of Cyrene, was forced to carry the cross of Jesus to that hill where two thieves had already been crucified. Jesus had no sleep, food, or water for several hours.

The soldiers nailed Jesus to the cross. He cried, "My God! My God! Why had You forsaken Me?" Finally, He cried, "It is finished." Then He "yielded up His spirit." The Son of God was dead.

The centurion exclaimed, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!" The veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. There was an earthquake. Darkness covered the land.

When the soldiers came to break the legs of Jesus and the thieves, they saw that Jesus was already dead, so they did not break His legs. However, a soldier pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. Jesus was dead.

Joseph of Arimethia and Nicodemus took the body of Jesus, bound it in strips of linen with the spices and put the body in Joseph's tomb. Then the disciples went away to mourn the death of the Lord.
