# Claims of the Christ

Who is Jesus? Who did He claim to be? No chapter of the Bible answers this question more clearly than John 8, where Jesus said, "I am the light of the world" (Jn. 8: 12). Jesus referred to Himself as "I Am" several times in the gospel of John. He said, "I am the bread of life" (6: 35). "I am the door of the sheep" (10: 7), and "I am the door" (10: 9). He added, "I am the good shepherd" (10: 11, 14). He told Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life" (11: 25). He assured His disciples, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (14: 6). Later He said, "I am the true vine" (15: 1). He told His Jewish critics, "Before Abraham was, I AM" (8: 58).

There is a direct connection between these statements and Exodus 3, where God spoke to Moses from the burning bush. When God told Moses what He wanted Moses to do, Moses asked, "When I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?"

God answered, "I AM WHO I AM." God told Moses to say, "I AM has sent me to you" (Ex. 3: 13-14). Jesus made a conscious connection between Himself and what God said in Exodus 3. Jesus identified Himself with God. This was not done by accident. It was done on purpose. Why? Because Jesus is "God...manifested in the flesh" (1 Tim. 3: 16). (See Philippians 2: 5-11).
