## ~ Tenants and Taxes ~

The sermon this morning will continue our series of studies in the Gospel of Mark, with the special emphasis on the last week in the earthly life of our Lord. Today we will look at Mark 12:1-17 as we think about "Tenants and Taxes." The first twelve verses of Mark 12 deal with the parable of the tenants or vinegrowers. Some scholars argue that this is the most important of all the parables of Jesus, for in it He is obviously talking about Himself as the Son who is sent by His Father, represented by the landowner, who is killed by the tenants.

The parable is followed by the question posed by the Pharisees and Herodians in their attempt to entrap Jesus. The passage teaches a very important point about the Christian's relationship to the civil government, the same theme discussed by Paul in Romans 13.

Tonight is singing night. We hope all of you will return for that. We also need to take note of the fact that this is the beginning of a new Bible School quarter.
