"SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

WHERE WILL WE STAND?

We live in a day when the only thing that is constant is change. Change has become so constant that the church now has people who are referred to as "change agents," who want to change the identity of the church to make it look more like the churches around them.

Some have divided the Bible into two categories of teachings: there are "salvation issues" and "non-salvation issues." Who decides which is which? That may be the heart of the problem. How will we decide which is a salvation issue and which is not?

In the final analysis the answer to that question is God. All authority ultimately resides with God. He has given all authority to His Son (Mt. 28:18). The Son sent the Holy Spirit to guide the apostles into all the truth (Jn. 16:13). That truth is recorded in the inspired word of God (2 Tim. 3:16-17). We must study the word of God to know the will of God.

There is a movement among some brethren to move away from New Testament teaching on matters of faith and practice. For example, the largest church in our brotherhood now offers two worship services: instrumental and non-instrumental. They were followed in this move by other churches, with rumors of still more churches of Christ adopting instrumental music in their worship services.

Where will it stop? When will it stop? Will it stop? Will we abandon the plea to restore New Testament Christianity? Have not some already done this? The Southern Hills Church of Christ is committed to being a New Testament church. Nothing less. Nothing more. Nothing other than a church that continues the plea for the restoration of New Testament Christianity.
