## The Man Born Blind

One of the seven signs around which John constructs his gospel account is the miracle of the man born blind (John 9). The miracle itself is described in 9:1-7. Neither this man nor his parents had sinned to cause the man to be born blind. His blindness was "(in order) that the works of God should be revealed in him" (v. 3). This miracle, like the other miracles Jesus performed, confirmed His claim--and the claim the Bible makes--that He is the Son of God (Jn. 20: 30-31).

The miracle brought different reactions. The man's neighbors were puzzled. The Pharisees accused Jesus of violating the Law of Moses. His parents were evasive as to whether the man was their son. However, when the Pharisees asked the former blind man to identify who had healed him, the man first said He was "A man called Jesus" (v. 11). Later the man said that Jesus was "a prophet" (v. 17). Then the man added, "If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing" (v. 33). Finally, he acknowledged that Jesus is the Lord. "And he worshiped Him" (v. 38).

On recent Sunday nights we studied John 8, where there are over twenty claims made by Jesus as to who He is, from where He came, and why He came. He is the Son of God, the light of the world, who came from the Father to save men from sin. We, too, should worship Him.
