## CHRISTIAN SUFFERING

The theme of First Peter is suffering: the suffering of Christ and the suffering of Christians. Christ suffered for us (1 Peter 2:21) and we will likely suffer for Him (1 Peter 4:16). The first mention of our suffering is in 1 Peter 1:6, while the initial reference to the suffering of Christ in the letter is in 1 Peter 1:11. Other references to suffering are 1 Peter 2:21-24; 3:14, 18; 4:1, 13, 15-19; 5:1 and 5:9-10.

The focus of our lesson today is 1 Peter 3:18. The verse makes five points. First, it gives us the greatest example of suffering: "For Christ also suffered." Second, it indicates the sufficiency of His suffering: "once for sins." Third, it explains the purpose of His suffering: "that He might bring us to God." Fourth, it emphasizes the extent of His suffering: "being put to death in the flesh." Fifth, the passage concludes with the result of His suffering: "made alive by the Spirit."

Christ suffered for us. We will be challenged by Satan in our efforts to live for Christ. This will likely involve suffering. If Christ suffered for us, we must be willing to suffer—and even die—for Him (Revelation 2:10).

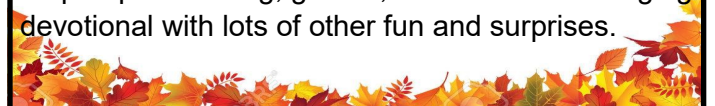
