~ When will Christ Return? ~

It is one of the most important questions of the ages: When will Christ return? Repeatedly throughout history there have been pundits who claimed to know that date, but in every case they have been wrong. How is it that such people can claim to know something that Jesus Himself did not know? Jesus referred to the Day of His return as "that day and hour." Then He added, "But of that day and hour, no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father" (Mk 13:32; cf. Mt 24:36).

Jesus discussed His second coming in Matthew 24 and 25, Luke 21 and Mark 13. Today we will focus on Mark 13 as part of our continuing series of sermons on the Gospel of Mark. That chapter begins with a question from one of His disciples about the beauty of the temple (13:1). That prompts Jesus to warn the disciples about the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70. The disciples ask, "When will these things be?" (See Matt. 24:3).

In Mark 13:5-30 Jesus answers their question about the fall of Jerusalem. Mark 13:31 is a transition verse. It introduces a change of topic. Mark 13:32-37 is a discussion of the return of our Lord. In the parallel in Matthew 24, it is clear that the disciples have actually asked two questions, not just one. Only at Matthew 24:36 does Jesus begin to discuss his return. Today we will discuss the return of Christ (Mk 13:32-37).
