The Glory of God

The word glory, when used in reference to God, refers to His exalted praise, honor and thanksgiving. He is the God who is full of glory and splendor. All glory, honor and praise belong to Him, for He is the living and true God.

Many Bible verses support this claim. For example, Stephen "gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God" (Acts 7:55). Paul wrote of "the glory of God" (Rom. 5:2). He wrote that "whatever you do, do all to the glory of God" (1 Cor. 10:31). We are to live "to the glory and praise of God" (Phil 1:11). In fact, the time will come when "every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Phil. 2:11).

The morning sermon, "The Glory of God," will study four important points about the glory of God. 1. Creation glorifies God (Ps. 19:1-3). 2. Christ glorifies God (Rom. 6:4). 3. Christians are to glorify God (Eph. 1:12,14). 4. The church is to glorify God (Eph. 3:21).

The picture will always remain in my mind of Batsell Barrett Baxter standing before an assembled church or a Bible class at Lipscomb with his open Bible in his left hand and his right hand clenched in a fist for emphasis. He would say "Man's greatest purpose is to glorify God." AMEN!

Our mission work this summer started in June and was fast and furious! Michael started off going to Baja CA, Mexico on the 6-14th. He and Wayne have been going there for a few years and the work there is increasing every year. Mario is the preacher and besides a congregation in Zapata, he is planting a congregation where he lives just a few miles away. The land was acquired by the congregation and building has started.

Wayne preaches and Michael teaches the teens & young adults which was about 30 this year. He focused on evangelism and how to conduct studies. Studies were also done in member's homes, and children's classes. The man who was leading this part is retiring and Michael and Wayne will take over that part of the work. There were 2 baptisms that week and many studies.

From July 1st - 12th we went to Canas and Tilaran in Costa Rica. The work there is going well with the congregations getting larger and members are very active and working. The local team was outstanding with many young people helping. It's great to see the new people that are so excited. Both congregations took such good care of us with food and keeping all our needs met.

The buildings were full and overflowing, the children's classes were so large because they were coming from the VBS classes that were held in the afternoon. A much different year than we've had for a while with all the Bible studies and interest! All the VBS numbers were up as well.
