The Plan of Salvation

What is the plan of salvation? It is the plan ordained by God for the redemption and salvation of mankind. It is revealed in detail in the Bible, and the inspired and authoritative word and will of God. It is the good news of the gospel, which is based on Jesus Christ (John 3:16-17).

What are the steps in God's plan? First, we must HEAR the gospel, which is the word of God. It is "the power of God to salvation" (Romans 1:16-17). "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17).

Second, we must respond to the gospel by FAITH (Hebrews 11:1,6). Third, we must REPENT of our sins (Luke 13:1-5; Acts 17:30). Then we must make the good CONFESSION of our faith before men (Romans 10:17). Finally, we must be BAPTIZED by immersion in order to receive the remission of our sins (Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16).

Remember that God "is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance" (2 Peter 3:9). "Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matthew 11:28).
