Our Purpose: Understanding Our Telos

What is life all about? The ancient Greeks used the word telos to mean "purpose, goal, or fulfillment." Everything has a telos—a hammer drives nails, shoes cover feet, benches hold weight. Using something contrary to its design leads to frustration. The same is true of our lives: we were made for a purpose, and when we miss it, life feels empty.

Scripture reveals that our telos can be summed up in four words:

Reflection – We were created to reflect God's glory (Gen. 1:26-27).

Relationship – We were made for fellowship with God and with one another (Gen. 2:18; 3:8).

Responsibility – God charged humanity to work, protect, and steward His creation (Gen. 1:28).

Redemption – Though sin mars our purpose, God offers grace and forgiveness through Jesus Christ (Gen. 3:15).

Are you living according to God's design—or are you chasing things that can never satisfy? True fulfillment is found only when we reflect God's glory, walk with Him, care for what He has given us, and live in Christ's redeeming grace.

Our hearts truly find rest only when they rest in Him.
