# Scriptural Foundation: The Standard for Deacons

The Apostle Paul outlines the qualities of deacons in 1 Timothy 3:8–13 (ESV):

- 8 Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued, not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain.
- **9** They must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience.
- 10 And let them also be tested first; then let them serve as deacons if they prove themselves blameless.
- 11 Their wives likewise must be dignified, not slanderers, but sober-minded, faithful in all things.
- 12 Let deacons each be the husband of one wife, managing their children and their own households well.
- 13 For those who serve well as deacons gain a good standing for themselves and also great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
