Bible Study

Bible study is one of the most important activities in which a Christian can engage. That includes both Bible study classes provided by the church for its members and others. How can we do the will of God if we do not know the will of God? How can we know the will of God if we do not study His inspired word, the Bible?

As Jesus said to God the Father, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth" (Jn. 17:17). As Jesus had already said, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (Jn. 8:32). How can we know that God's word is truth? Because it comes to us and is inspired by God.

Nowhere is that more clearly stated than by Paul in 2 Timothy 3:14-17. There Paul writes that "the Holy Scriptures are able to make you wise for salvation through faith, which is in Christ Jesus" (v. 15). Then Paul adds, "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God" (v. 16). Therefore, the scriptures make the man or woman of God "complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (v. 17).

So please stay for Bible class and continue to study God's word at home. "Study to show yourself approved to God" (2 Tim. 2:15).

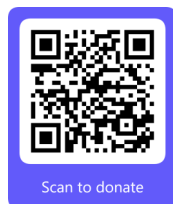

Greetings in the mighty name of our Savior Jesus Christ. We have come to the last two months of year 2025, we thank you Southern Hills very much for all the support, financially, physically, and spiritually, because of you all programs have been successful throughout the year, May God bless you all.

Over 25 kids were fed with rice, mince and Mazoe juice at Mpisini. The Children feeding program has a major positive impact in all the areas where we work, not only saving children from malnutrition but also bringing the parents who come with their children. Many parents have been won for Christ and baptized for the remission of sins.

We had our Gospel Revival Meeting at Mpisini where we were doing a follow up to our previous gathering where we felt there was a need to continue teaching as commanded Matthew 28:20 the new Christians and other brethren on true worship. We thank you very much for helping with food for this Gospel Meeting because it is also very important to not only baptize, but to continue to teach for the spiritual growth of the whole Church.

We thank you so very much for feeding our fellow brethren in the bush, 55 bags of Mealie meal were distributed to the starving families at Kumbudzi and Thuthuka. The Church leaders in the Mtshabezi area asked us to send their message of sincere and heartfelt gratitude for food relief.

Without your support so many of our brethren would die in these very rural villages. Many still only have one meal per day if they are lucky enough to have Mealie Meal.

We also visited the boreholes drilled by loving American brethren. Water is crucial to life in Zimbabwe. With water our brethren can plant drip irrigation gardens. We could report so much more but we'll just say it again - **THANK YOU** to our Southern Hills brethren!
