Before anything else existed, God existed—and with Him existed a fixed and holy moral character. Right and wrong were not discovered by humanity over time, nor negotiated by cultures along the way. They flow from who God is. Because God is good, what He approves is good. Because God is holy, what He forbids is not. Christian ethics, then, does not begin with human opinion, but with the unchanging character of God Himself.

That starting point immediately confronts us. Most believers can remember times when their sense of what felt right conflicted with what Scripture actually taught. That discomfort is not a flaw in God's Word—it is evidence that God intends His Word to shape us. Scripture was never meant to merely echo our instincts; it was given to train them.

For this reason, one of the Bible's clear purposes is to teach God's people how to live in ways that please Him. The psalms describe a blessed life as one that delights in God's law and walks according to it, allowing His Word to guard the heart and direct the path (Ps 1:1–2; 119:1–6, 9, 105). Paul echoes this by explaining that Scripture is God-breathed and effective for training in righteousness, fully equipping believers for every good work (2 Tim 3:16–17). From the beginning, faithful discipleship has involved learning how we "ought to walk and please God" (1 Thess 4:1).

Some worry that emphasizing ethics distracts from the gospel or risks offending others. Scripture allows no such separation. The same Word that brings salvation also produces obedience. Jesus tied love directly to keeping His commands and charged His disciples with teaching others to observe all that He commanded (John 14:15; Matt 28:20). The gospel forgives—but it also transforms.

Because God does not change, His moral standards remain unchanged. While circumstances and technologies change, morality does not. God's Word continues to provide wisdom, direction, and discernment for every generation. In the end, the question is unavoidable: if God has spoken, will our lives be shaped by His standards—or by our own? – Freddie Klein
