Finding the "Third Way" in Christian Ethics

Christian ethics often feels most difficult when obedience appears costly. What happens when faithfulness to God seems to place us in danger, conflict, or impossible situations? Scripture repeatedly teaches that God never requires His people to sin in order to obey Him—and He often provides a wiser path than we first imagine.

Consider the Hebrew midwives in Egypt. Scripture tells us they feared God and refused Pharaoh's command to kill infants (Exod. 1:17). When questioned, they explained that Hebrew women gave birth quickly. The text never says they lied. Instead, it highlights their fear of God and God's blessing for preserving life (v. 21). Their example reminds us that obedience does not always require open confrontation—or moral compromise—but faithful, God-honoring wisdom.

Throughout Scripture, God's people face moments where only two sinful options seem available. Yet the Bible consistently reveals a "third way." Silence, refusal to participate in evil, strategic action, and trust in God's providence often allow obedience without violating truth (1 Cor. 10:13). Scripture forbids speaking what we believe to be false, but it does not condemn wise actions that conceal truth from those who intend harm.

Jesus Himself modeled this wisdom. Though He is the Truth, He often remained silent before His accusers, speaking only when lawfully required (Matt. 26:63–64). His obedience did not abandon justice; it fulfilled God's purpose. The lesson is clear: God's law does not contradict itself. Christians are never forced to choose a "lesser sin." Faithfulness means trusting that God's commands are good, unified, and always accompanied by a righteous path forward.

MISSIONS MEMO...

Velaphi Mlangeni • Bulawayo, Zimbabwe

As 2025 has come to an end, we find it proper to thank you our loving Brothers and Sisters for so many accomplishments made during this past year.

First, we thank our Elders at Rainbow Church of Christ for their wise decision in starting this evangelism work in Zimbabwe in 2002. This has resulted in 15,484 World Bible Students being taught the Bible and 3314 baptized (that we could count). 62 congregations have been planted in various districts throughout Matebeleland and Midlands Provinces.

Twelve boreholes were drilled, and water provided to the poor as Zimbabwe has perennial droughts. Imagine how many would not survive during these droughts without water?

We thank our Southern Hills Elders and brethren for starting a program of food distribution in Zimbabwe. It's very difficult to preach to hungry people. Our Lord experienced this. You have no idea how many lives you have saved from starvation!

We thank our Rainbow Elders for starting the School of Preaching in Bulawayo. The goal of this school is to train church leaders how to win lost souls. It's also important that church leaders are taught to respect the authority of the Bible in all religious matters. This school will continue fortifying the church in Zimbabwe by training men to respect Bible authority for many years to come even after we are all gone.

We're thankful for so many other things including monthly support for full time preachers, trucks used for preaching; especially in remote bush areas for those who need baptism to distant rivers, drip-irrigation resources, tents for Gospel Meetings, wheelchairs for disabled, funds for medical treatments and funeral expenses when we lose very close relatives. The list is endless. All this shows that we are one big God's Family. The weekly Bulawayo Gospel Radio Program is reaching tens of thousands.

We have just mentioned a few areas where you our Brothers and Sisters have partnered with us. We sincerely thank you for all the good things you have done and are still doing in Zimbabwe. If you don't help, who will?

Yes, we are all God's children, and we know full well that our partnership in the Gospel is genuine and we shall carry it through to completion until Christ calls us home.

Please pray for us so that we may continue to propagate the Gospel Truth with all vigor!
